- * Served in United States Air Force, 1957-1963; Co-Pilot of KC97G Aerial Refueling Aircraft at Malmstrom Air Force Base in Great Falls
- * Mechanical Engineer for the Montana Power Company, 1964-1974; Designer for Corette coal-fired electrical generating plant in Billings; Provided maintenance support for hydroelectric generating plants near Great Falls, Thompson Falls, Polson & Ennis
- * Engineer and manager for the proposal, design, construction, operation and maintenance of Colstrip Units 1, 2, 3 & 4, 1968-1987; Supervised design, equipment purchasing and construction of the coal-fired power plants, housing and infrastructure in the town of Colstrip, and the 500,000 Volt electrical power transmission lines between Colstrip and Townsend; The Colstrip project was the largest private-capital-investment venture in Montana and generates over 2000 Megawatts of electrical power for five utilities in the Northwestern United States
- * Served as President and Chief Operating Officer of Western Energy, a subsidiary of Montana Power Company, 1987-1988; Western Energy was the nation's 12th largest marketer of coal; Served as President and Chief Executive of Entech, a subsidiary of Montana Power Company, 1988-1992; Entech operated non-utility businesses including coal, oil and gas development, long-distance telephone service, waste management and gold mining
- * Chief Executive Officer of Montana Power Company, 1992-1997; Montana Power provided electrical service to 280,000 customers and natural gas service to 140,000 customers
- * Life Member of American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME); Member of ASME committee on System and Facilities Design
- * Member of Montana Tech Foundation Board of Directors; Montana Tech Local Executive Board; Butte Chamber of Commerce; Butte Chapter Chairman of SCORE (Counselors to America's Small Business); Board member of Butte Center for the Performing Arts.
